

**Application for the Hazel Chrisman Memorial Scholarship
in the Department of English and Theatre**

The Hazel Chrisman Memorial English Scholarship is awarded to a full-time freshman English major with good high school GPA and ACT score with financial need. The scholarship is renewable with a 3.6 GPA in English courses and satisfactory overall progress toward a degree. The winner will receive around \$250. If you meet these requirements and would like to be considered for the award, complete the steps below.

1. Write a letter that discusses any activities and personal characteristics that might qualify you for this award. You might include scholarly interests and honors, papers or presentations, or other exemplary academic achievements. In addition, provide information about any leadership activities you may have undertaken during your college career—academic or non-academic, at Eastern or in the community. Finally, briefly sketch your career plans and goals after graduation. Address this letter to English Department, 101 Mattox Hall.
2. Request recommendations from two Eastern Kentucky University professors who strongly support your application. At least one of these recommendations, two if possible, must be from a faculty member of the Department of English and Theatre. These letters should be sent to English Department, 101 Mattox Hall.
3. Supply the information requested at the bottom of this page and submit it, along with your application letter by **Feb. 26, 2021**:
